EVENTS AT HIGH COUNTRY CONFERENCE CENTER

Catering at High Country Conference Center has taken on a new look for your safety and the safety of our employees.

We would like you to express the importance of adhering to these guidelines for your safety and all in attendance.

For our Guests:

- ◆ If you or your co-hosts have been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 14 days or are showing COVID-19 symptoms, please stay at home. Anyone who has had close contact with a person who has COVID-19 should also stay home and monitor their health. Those who live with high risk individuals should also consider the potential risk to their loved ones.
 - ◆ Masks are required for all attendees at High Country Conference Center. Please check with the event organizer if they will be providing masks or if you need to bring your own.
 - ◆ Please wash your hands before entering the venue. Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds when entering and exiting social gatherings. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
 - ◆ The doors may be open at the event. This is to reduce touch points and improve air circulation.
 - ◆ Minimize gestures that promote close contact. For example, don't shake hands, do elbow bumps or give hugs. Instead wave and verbally greet them.
 - ◆ Be sure to check in with your event organizer. They will be keeping an attendee list that may be required by health officials for contact tracing.
 - ◆ Hand washing and sanitizer will be available for you inside the venue.
 - ◆ Please follow directional signage and line queuing instructions.
 - ◆ Tables and chairs will be arranged to allow for social distancing.
 - ◆ All food will be served by a staff member behind a wide table and a sneeze guard.
 - ◆ Touchless garbage cans and recycling will be provided.
 - ◆ Serving areas and all frequently touch surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
